




Working in harmony with lunar cycles

Horn Silica (501)

These formulations are made from minerals (such as silica used in the «501») or organic matter (such as cow dung used in the «500»). First, we bury them in the soil during six months and then, we dynamize them and spray them on the vine.

We restore the soil balance by adding organic matter into the ground. The soil is then nourished and spread its energy to the vine.

BRINGING ENERGY BACK INTO THE SOIL

Our Biodynamic formulations are handmade and we use them to increase soil fertility.

WE GROW OUR OWN PLANTS

We have planted over 18 plant species with therapeutic qualities. Indeed, each of them has a specific purpose: to take care of the vine throughout the seasons.



HERBAL TREATMENTS GROWING

THE DRYING

Once harvested, we place these plants for a few weaks in a homemade dryer made of hessian.





HERBAL TEAS & DECOCTIONS

We use with these plants to produce our own herbal teas and decoctions. We spray them on the vine in order to prevent diseases, strengthen it and limit the use of vine treatments.

TRANSFORMING



DISTILLATION

With our still, we produce our own essential oils and hydrosols. Indeed, they are natural, powerful and have antifungal properties.

HERBAL TEAS



Nettle (Nitrogen, Iron)



Chamomile (Sulphur, Calcium, Potash)



Achilée Millefeuille (Potash, Sulphur, Salicylic Acid)



Dandelion (Silica)



Wicker (Salicylic Acid)



lvy (Chlorogenic Acid)

They stimulates the vine's natural defences and boosts fruit maturity.

DECOCTIONS



Horsetail (Silica 8-10%)



Bamboo (Silica 75% in the bamboo sugar)



Oak Bark (Calcium, Gallic Acid)



Buckthorn Bark (Acide Gallique)

They strenghten plant tissues and prevent vine diseases.

Thyme

(Carvacol 15%)



Moutains Savory

(Carvacol 40-50%)



Oregano

(Carvacol 60-70%)



Rosemary

(Alpha Pinède 20-27%)



Coriander

(Linalol 70-85%)



Lavandin Grosso

(Linalol 30-40%)

They have bactericidal, antifungal and antiseptic properties.

HARMONY OF MATURATION


In order to preserve the fruit quality, we work with different winemaking and ageing containers:
